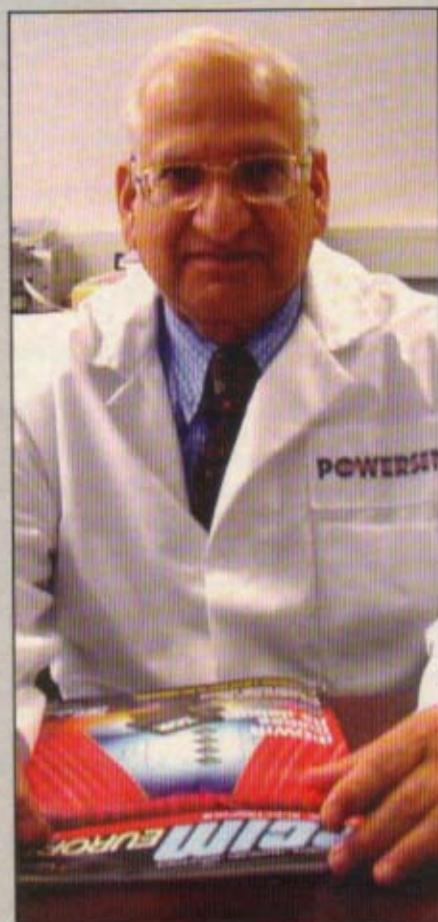
Meeting Madan had always been an exciting event for me, especially when discussing new ideas for the semiconductor market and how to realize them.
